Young V&A (formerly V&A Museum of Childhood) opened in 1872 as the Bethnal Green Museum, East London's first ever Museum and embedded itself at the heart of the local community. Over 150 years later, the Grade II* listed site in Bethnal Green has been radically rejuvenated to become Young V&A, a new national museum and powerhouse of creativity for children and young teenagers that puts children and their creative futures front and centre.

In addition to hosting your event under the world-renowned V&A umbrella, hiring Young V&A is a fantastic opportunity to support the work the Museum is doing with local communities, and to champion, nurture, and inspire the innovators of tomorrow. The McLain Hall

The McLain Hall is at the heart of the Museum, both literally and historically, featuring the original mosaic marble floor that was laid in 1872 when the Museum was first opened. Lit by magnificent half-moon windows, the McLain Hall features wrought iron architecture and lofty ceilings that create an open, expansive space. At one end, the dramatic spiral staircase provides both a beautiful vista and a dramatic location for wedding entrances, musical performances and speeches.

With a large in-built bar, the McLain Hall is a fabulous spot for a drinks reception, dancefloor party, or bar/bat mitzvah. For more formal seated dinners or wedding receptions, guests can dine beneath the sweeping ceiling and overhead balconies.



Exhibitions



FAQs

Is Young V&A licensed for civil ceremonies?

Yes, Young V&A is licensed for Civil Marriage and Civil Partnership ceremonies. Please be aware that you must book your registrar directly via the Borough of Tower Hamlets and this is not something the venue can do for you. We highly recommend securing your ceremony with them before booking the venue. They can be contacted via www.towerhamlets. gov.uk

Is Young V&A available to hire for engagement parties, anniversaries and other celebrations?

Yes, the Museum can be hired to celebrate parties and anniversaries. The information in this brochure is relevant for all types of private celebrations so please do contact us for further information.

What is included in the venue hire fee?

The venue hire fee includes exclusive use of the agreed event areas, a dedicated Event Manager, security staff, cleaning staff, an electrician, and a floor manager. If you are hiring Young V&A for a seated dinner, the pre dinner drinks area is included within the one fee and is not a separate cost.

The set-up time seems very short, how does that work?

We are open to the public 7 days a week until 5:45pm so we appreciate the turnaround from daytime museum to exclusive event venue can be daunting! However, we are very well practised at creating beautiful, memorable and magical events in as little as 45 mins. This is down to using approved suppliers such as caterers, florists and production companies who know the building intimately and are equipped and experienced enough to deliver fabulous events in very short set up times.

Can we use our own suppliers?

As a Grade I listed building with priceless works on display and a short set-up time, you must work with our approved list of suppliers (listed below) for catering, production, flowers and entertainment. By using our knowledgeable approved suppliers, we can ensure that not only is the Museum and its collections protected but that you will receive a high level of service due to their experience of working in our wonderful spaces. Whilst we do not have specify which planners and photographers can work at the Museum, do contact us for some suggestions.

Can we supply our own drinks?

You are welcome to provide your own drinks. We don't charge a corkage fee but your chosen caterer will charge an ancillary amount to chill, deliver and serve the drinks so do check with each caterer regarding their policy.

Can you recommend any wedding planners or wedding photographers?

Yes, if you would like to employ the services of a dedicated wedding planner to help pull the finer details together, we have a number of wedding planners we recommend, who have extensive experience of delivering excellence at V&A sites. We also have a number of wonderful wedding photographers and videographers who have captured the beauty of the V&A for our wedding clients and have lots of brilliant contacts if you would like recommendations.


