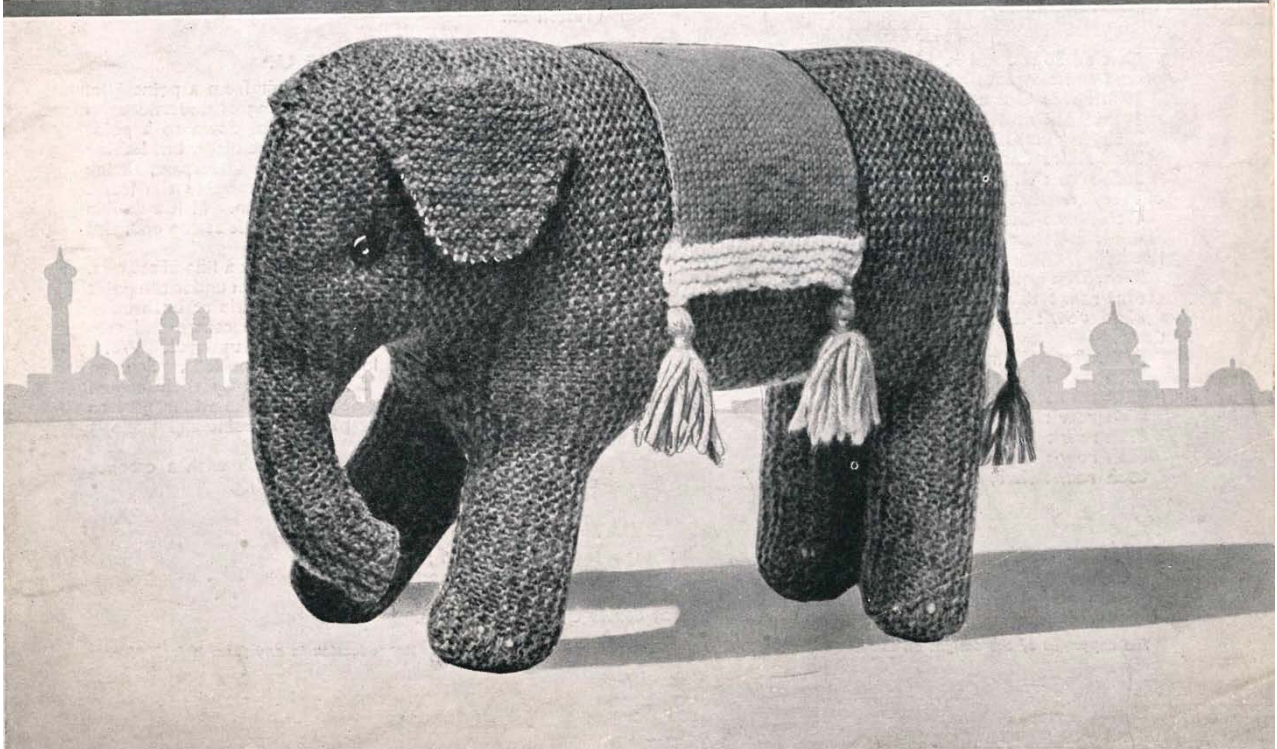
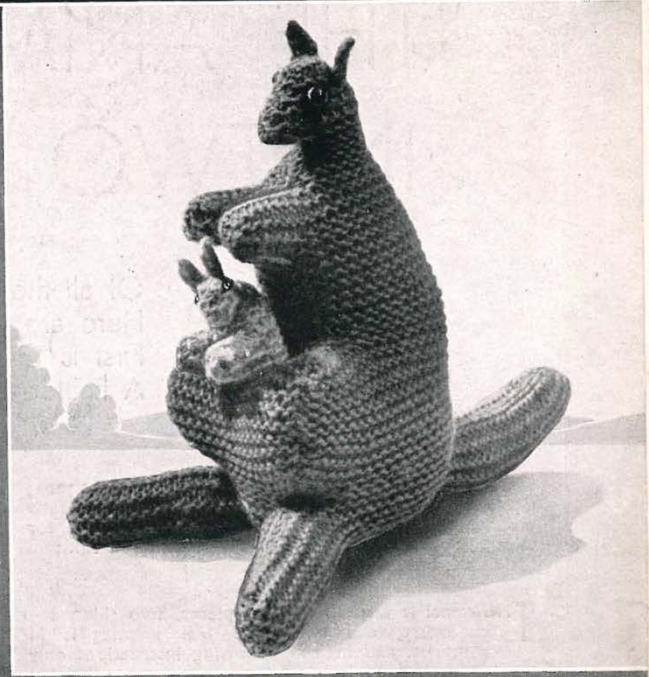
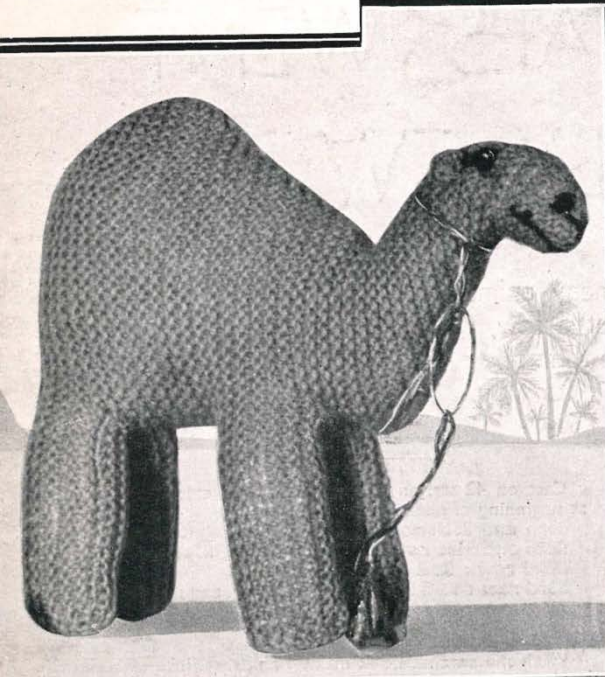

KNITTED CAMEL, KANGAROO and ELEPHANT *(Oddments of 4-ply Wool)*

"THE ANIMALS WENT IN TWO BY TWO—

Of all the many animals,
Here are just a few,
First is Clara Camel,
A knitted toy for you.

MATERIALS

One ounce of fawn 4-ply fingering or equivalent yarn; a pair of No. 10 knitting pins; a coarse steel or fine bone crochet hook; stuffing (use material unsuitable for salvage); 2 beads; short lengths of coloured silk; a little dark brown or black wool.

THE camel is worked in five pieces, two sides, one underpart, and two ears. All knitting is in garter-st. and in the following instructions only shaping rows are given. All other rows are knitted without alteration.

THE SIDES

Cast on 36 sts. and k. 14 rows, inc. 1 st. at beginning of 2nd and alternate rows.

15th row : Cast off 18, k. to end.

16th, 18th and 20th rows : Inc. in first st.

28th, 30th and 32nd rows : K. first 2 tog.

33rd row : Cast on 18, k. to end.

34th row : K. first 2 tog. Now k. 2 tog. at beginning of every alternate row until 36 sts. remain.

47th row : Cast off 18, k. to end.

48th, 50th and 52nd rows : K. first 2 tog., inc. in last st.

55th, 57th and 59th rows : Inc. in last st.

61st row : K. first 2 tog., inc. in last st.

62nd row : K. last 2 tog. Repeat these 2 rows 7 times.

77th row : K. first 2 tog.

78th row : K. last 2 tog. Repeat these 2 rows once.

85th row : K. 7, k. 2 tog.

86th row : K. 2 tog., k. 6.

87th row : K. 5, k. 2 tog.

88th row : K. 2 tog., k. 4.

89th row : K. 3, k. 2 tog. Cast off.

THE UNDERPART

Cast on 42 sts. and k. 14 rows, then cast off 18 sts. at beginning of next 2 rows.

35th and 36th rows : Cast on 18 sts. K. to end.

50th and 51st rows : Cast off 18 sts., k. to end.

52nd row : K. 2 tog., k. 2, k. 2 tog.

53rd row : K. 2 tog. twice. K. 2 tog. and fasten off.

THE EARS

With the crochet hook make 4 ch., s-st. into first ch. to form a ring, work 4 d.c., 4 tr., 4 d.c. into the ring. Fasten off.

TO MAKE UP

Sew the two main pieces together from a point $\frac{1}{2}$ in. from top of front legs (the beginning of underneath of neck) over the head, along back and down to a point $\frac{1}{2}$ in. before the commencement of back legs, but leaving an opening for stuffing. Sew in the underpart, fitting legs to legs, the small pointed end towards the front. Stuff firmly and complete the back seam. Plait a double strand of wool for the tail, leaving a tuft at the end, and sew in position.

With dark brown or black wool work a line of stem-st. to mark the mouth, keeping it well down under the point of the nose and making it droop a little at both ends. Make a short line upwards from the centre and two short lines from the top of this, sloping upwards. Work two French knots to indicate the nostrils. Sew on brown beads for eyes. Sew the ears by their centre towards the back of the head, with the wider part to the back. Pull the wider part to a point and make it protrude a little.

Pat the animal into shape and finish with a crochet chain of bright silk for a leading string.

ABBREVIATIONS

St., stitch; k., knit; tog., together; s., slip; inc., increase, by knitting into front and back of same st.; garter-st. is every row k. (when counting, note that every ridge represents 2 rows); ch., chain; d.c., double crochet; tr., treble.

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
