



Knitting patterns—children's accessories

The Cone-Patterned Bonnet (6 – 18 months)

Suggested yarn: 1 oz. of "Emu" Unshrinkable 3-ply Vest Wool (about 140 1/2 yds. to 1 oz.).

Needle size: One pair of knitting needles No. 9 and one yard of ribbon.

Measurements: The bonnet measures 12 1/2 ins. round face. From front to centre back 6 ins.

Abbreviations: K., knit; P., purl; st, or sts., stitch or stitches; tog., together; rep., repeat; g.st., garter-stitch (every row K.); inc., increase (work into front and back of same st.); m.st., moss-stitch (K. I, P. I to end of row, then on return row reverse order of sts. so that a K. st. comes over a P. st., and vice versa)

Instructions:

Using No. 9 needles, cast on 90 sts. and work 8 rows in g.st.

1st row (wrong side): K. 3, P. to last 3 sts., K. 3.

2nd row: K.

Rep. last 2 rows once more.

5th row: K. 3, *K. 4, P. I. Rep. from + to last 7 sts., K. 7.

6th row: K. 3, *P. 4, insert needle into previous row of next st., K. it but do not let st. off needle, then K. the st. on left-hand needle. Rep. from * to last 7 sts., P. 4, K. 3.

7th row: K. 7, *P. 2, K. 4. Rep. from * to last 3 sts., K. 3.

8th row: K. 3. *P. 4, K. I, insert needle into previous row of next st. K. it but do not let st. off needle, then K. the st. on left-hand needle. Rep. from * to last 7 sts., P. 4, K. 3.

9th row: K. 7. *P. 3, K. 4. Rep. from - to last 3 sts., K. 3.

10th row: K. 3, - P. 4. K. 2, insert needle into previous row of next st., K. it but do not let st. off needle, then K. the st. still on left-hand needle. Rep. from * to last 7 sts., P. 4, K. 3.

11th row: K. 7, * P. 4, K. 4. Rep. from * to last 3 sts., K. 3.

12th row: K. 3. 7 P. 4, K. tog Rep. from * to last 7 sts., P. 4, K.

Rep. these 12 rows 3 times more, then rep. 1st and 2nd rows twice more.

Next row: K.

Now shape back.

1st row: *K. 8, K. 2 tog. Rep. from * to end.

2nd and every alternate row: K.

3rd row: *K. 7, K. 2 tog. Rep. from * to end.

5th row: *K. 6, K. 2 tog. Rep. from + to end.

Continue thus, working | st. less between each dec. in every alternate row, until the 17th

row is worked thus: *K. 2 tog. Rep. from * to end. Break off wool, thread through remaining sts., draw up and fasten off.

MAKING UP

Press work lightly on wrong side. Sew up back seam to edge of shaping and press seam. Sew on ribbons.
