THE COSTUME OF POWER: FASHION IN RENAISSANCE ITALY

Introduction

Join us for a five-week course exploring the art of dressing in the Italian Renaissance. From luxury textiles to sartorial texts, this is a fascinating journey through Renaissance clothing.

This five-week course, dedicated to the art of dressing in the Italian Renaissance, will explore a fascinating story of taste, enterprise, power, and social conventions. From the early 15th century, through to the early 17th century, we will explore the different regions and cities - including Venice, Florence and Milan - where luxury textiles were produced during the Renaissance (silk, velvets and lace, for example).

Paintings, sculptures, and other forms of artistic production will be our primary source for investigating fashion practices (the V&A Collections providing wonderful examples full of true-to-life details), whilst written sources from the period also become a lens to study the clothing cultures of the elite members of the Italian courts.

Finally, we'll discover the fast-developing field of research that underpins the precise reproduction of Renaissance clothing. The course does not require any prior knowledge and is suitable for anyone with an interest in fashion and textile history, Renaissance art, and Italy in general, as well as those interested in recreating period clothing, or costumes for theatre, film or television.
